There is a minor chip to the paintwork above the top hole on one side and there is some crazing throughout. Is otherwise in good condition.

This lot has several hairline cracks running down from the rim, a star crack to the base and some staining to the interior.

- 1169 A stepped hardwood chest fitted 8 short drawers above 3 graduated cupboards with grilled doors and raised on a platform base H 54" L 52" d 16" £50-75
- There is slight scratching and a small section of timber is missing to the front of one drawer*
- 1170 A 17th/18th Century oak oval drop flap gateleg dining table 29"h x 40"w x 15" when closed x 55" when extended £70-100
- There is a 12" split to 1 of the flaps, the top is later than the base and is in need of a polish*
- 1171 A carved oak coffer of panelled construction, the front carved oak leaves, 24"h x 33"w x 13 1/2"d £90-120
