The top has some slight water marks
- 847 A set of 6 carved mahogany bar back dining chairs with carved and pierced mid rails, upholstered drop in seats, £170-200
One chair has a loose frame and another has old but treated worm. All of the chairs are scuffed and 1 has an old repair to the stretcher.
