- 1015 A Georgian shaped inlaid mahogany cutlery box with hinged lid 40cm h x 29cm w x 26cm d £50-75
Lid is slightly warped, cock beading is missing to the side, damage by lock, escutcheon is missing
- 1016 A Victorian octagonal rosewood wine table raised on pillar and tripod base 71cm h x 50cm w x 51cm d £40-60
Water marks to the top, column and base are scuffed in places
- 1017 A 19th Century circular revolving 3 tier dumb waiter, raised on pillar and tripod base with brass casters 109cm h x 60cm diam to the lower tier £80-120
Ring and water marks to the top 2 tiers, the lower tier has a split and old repair
- 1018 A 19th Century inlaid mahogany bow front corner cabinet, the upper section fitted a shelf with dentil cornice, the associated base enclosed by a panelled door above a drawer and with dummy drawers to the side 191cm h x 40cm w x 40cm d £40-60
The escutcheons to the top and base are missing, the right leg is damaged
- 1019 An 18th/19th Century elm wine table raised on a pillar and tripod base 69cm h x 63cm w x 65cm d £40-60
The top is wobbly, has a split, water marks and a crude repair to the under side
- 1020 A 1930's Art Deco carved oak and ply sideboard with raised back, fitted a shelf and 2 drawers enclosed by pair of panelled doors, raised on bun feet 100cm h x 120 w x 49cm d £40-60
The top has light pitting and ring marks, veneer is rising to the left hand side
- 1021 Adam Beyer, an 18th century square piano marked Adam Beyer London, 1782, Compton Street, Soho contained in an inlaid mahogany case 80cm h x 157cm w x 52cm d £150-200
The lid has a split in 2 places, the ivory keys have parrot damage to them (the parrot liked to chew the keys,) there are some missing sections of ivory from the front, a section of veneer missing to the right hand edge, the foot pedal is loose and contained within as is lyre shaped music stand (f). This item has been registered as required with gov.uk for the purpose of being sold at auction, if subsequently re-sold it will need to be re-registered.
- 1022 A Queen Anne style figured walnut double corner cocktail cabinet with shaped cornice, the upper section fitted shelves enclosed by arched panelled doors above brushing slide, the base enclosed by panelled doors, raised on bracket feet 187cm x 90cm w x 54cm d £60-90
- 1023 A 19th Century American turned mahogany rocking chair, the seat and back upholstered, raised on turned supports 106cm h x 53cm w x 58cm d £40-60
- 1024 An 18th/19th Century oak bureau the fall front revealing a well fitted interior above 3 long drawers 105cm h x 68cm x 55cm d £50-75
- 1025 A 17th/18th Century fruitwood hall chair with shaped splat back and needlework seat, raised on turned supports 109cm h x 48cm w x 41cm d £30-50
There are signs of old but treated worm in places, the back has an iron brace repair and the seat is damaged in places
- 1026 A 19th Century mahogany secretaire chest with secretaire and 3 long drawers, raised on bracket feet 103cm h x 97cm w x 49cm d £80-120
Top right corner is missing sections 5mm x 15mm and 5cm split. The back right leg is stuck and chipped. There is a crack to the front right of secretaire drawer. The veneers have been replaced to front left upright. The front left leg has been repaired. There are chips to veneer on the bottom drawer
